Maths

As **Mathematicians** we will explore the place value of numbers up to 100. We will read and write numbers in numerals and words. We will identify number sequences and explore number patterns. We will use concrete, pictorial and mental methods to add, subtract, multiply and divide numbers. We will recognise, find, name and write fractions.

English

As **readers and writers** we will explore the story Eliot Midnight Superhero. We will listen to, discuss and express views about poems and stories. We will draw on what we already know and background information to make inferences about stories. We will develop positive attitudes and stamina for writing by writing character profiles, stories and poems. We will develop our understanding of punctuation and sentence

As **healthy individuals** we will explore the importance of exercise, eating the right amount of different types of food, and hygiene.

We will discuss and share our emotions in a healthy and constructive manner.
