Maths

As Mathematicians we will focus on multiplication and division. We will look at making equal groups and how to share equally. We will use a variety of equipment to help us with our learning, moving our learning from pictorial to abstract. We will also continue to develop our reasoning and problem solving skills.

Wellbeing

As individuals we will explore what growth mindset means and how it differs from a fixed mindset. We will learn the importance of caring about animals and the world around us.

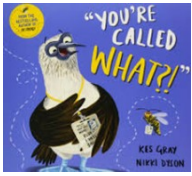
Literacy

As readers and writers we will develop our skills to help us write a non-chronological report. We will use our trip to White Post Farm to inspire us. We will be focusing on suffixes to compare the animals. We will be consolidating our learning from over the year including capital letters and full stops.

Global and Cultural

As explorers of the world we will identify the continents and oceans different animals live in.

We will also be looking at the different symbols in religion and what they mean.

STEM

As technicians we will identify a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will discover which animals are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will take a look in our local environment and understand how we can take care of the animals around us.

Arts

As creative artists we will create animal art. We will look at using watercolours and pastels to create our art piece.

Computing

As digital learners we will use the ipads to help develop our learning across all areas. We will use the 4D room to immerse ourselves in the oceans and continents around the world. Before doing this we will talk to the children about online safety.
