The school council would like the children of Inkersall to take part in Christmas Jumper Day on 14th

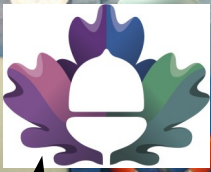


December. The council would like every child (and adult) to come to school in festive wear and donate 50p to Save the Children. We look forward to raising money for this brilliant charity!
