Remote Learning

The platform for setting online learning will be via Class Dojo.

- Teachers will plan and upload work to Class Dojo and will provide feedback to parents/carers and/or children.
- Work may be set by adults other than your child's usual class teacher.
- In the event that a child is not able to access remote learning, then paper copies will be provided where possible.
- Teachers will provide feedback on children's work daily; however, there may be instances where communication is delayed, as the teacher has some children both at home and at school. In this instance, communication will generally take place before or after school – but not beyond 5.30pm. In some cases, teaching assistants may provide the feedback to children.
- Work will be planned weekly. A timetable will be uploaded on Sunday ready for the week and then work uploaded daily.
- Work will be uploaded and shared via Class Dojo.
- Teachers will access pupils' work through Class Dojo and will provide feedback on submitted work each day (prior to the setting of new tasks).
- Zoom class sessions will be held sometimes daily or a couple of times each week.

Accessing Remote Learning

Weekly wellbeing telephone calls - On a weekly basis a member of our staff team will phone you and your child to 'touch base' and find out about the home learning adventures taking place.

Class Dojo messenger - If you have any questions or would like any advice, please feel free to contact the class teacher via the message option on Class Dojo.

Feedback on learning activities - Our teachers love to see the learning that is happening remotely. Pictures of your child's learning can be sent via Class Dojo. Teachers will be able to provide praise, assess and feedback on the learning activities that have been completed.

Where a child is having difficulty accessing work a teacher will talk through learning:

Explaining/modelling/scaffolding new knowledge and skills

Videos - SEND children accessing personalised video for them to watch for their guided input

Interventions - Named SEND children identified for additional input/boosting- Speech/Language Programmes/ Phonics. S&L sessions will continue remotely with the named TA and the SALT.
